In response to your letter of the 2nd, received on the 3rd instant, answer to which has been withheld pending an examination of the record in the application of your sister, Miss Hannah E. Hayes, of 1369 Calhoun Street, Baltimore, Md., for reimbursement in connection with the pension granted to your mother, Frances A., widow of John W. Hayes, late of Co. C, 39th U. S. C. Inf., Ctt. No. 681,969, you are advised that the claim was disallowed on May 13, 1913, on the ground that the pensioner left sufficient assets to meet the expenses of her last sickness and burial, and hence no person was entitled to collect the accrued pension under the claim.
