A. D., 1916, before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace

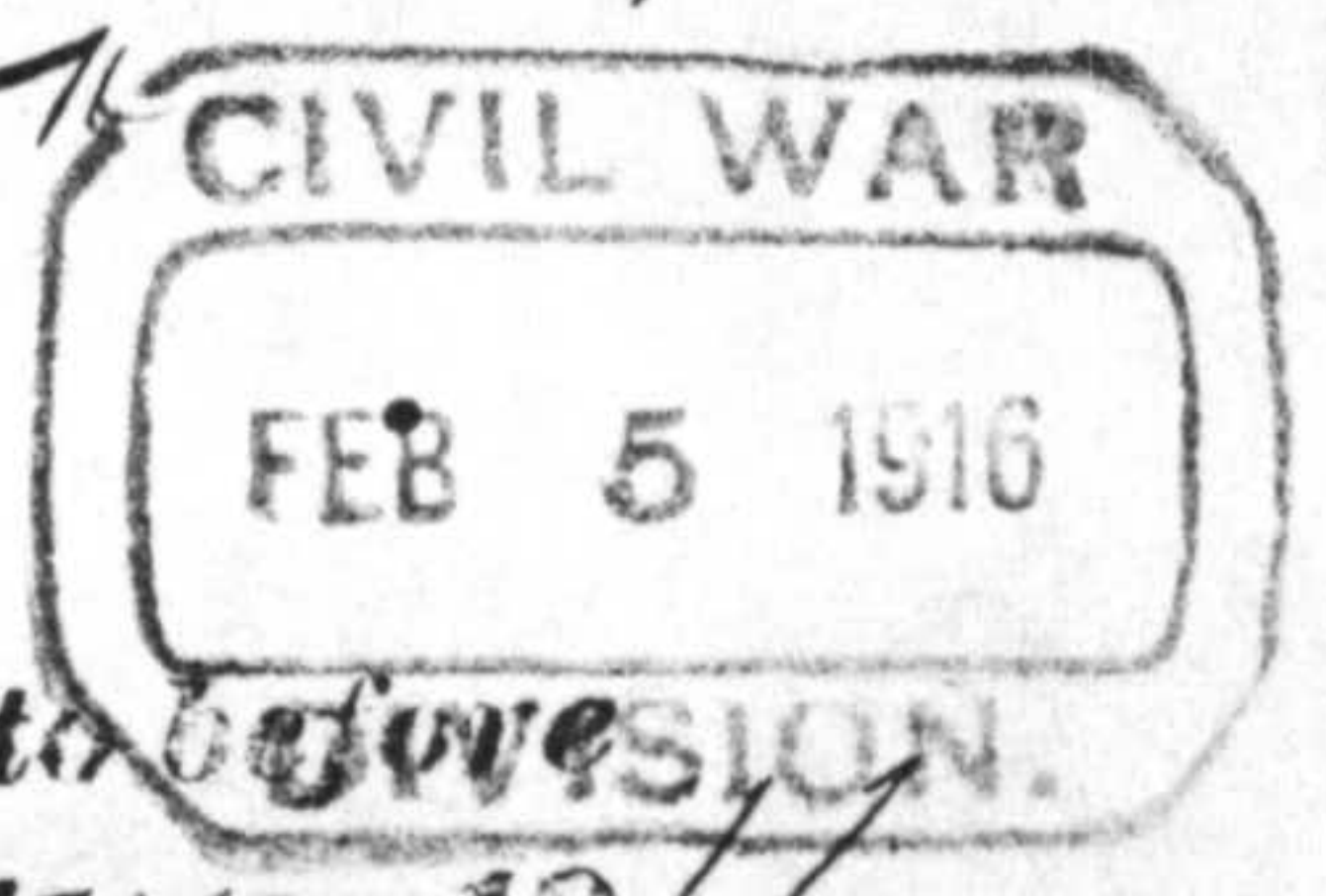
of the said state, in and for the City of Baltimore aforesaid, personally appeared
