

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore ss:

On this 4th day of December, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and fifteen personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and state aforesaid Maryport Mitchell aged 68 years, a resident of Baltimore City, County of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the Act of Congress, Approved April 19, 1908.

That she is the widow of Peter Mitchell, who was

Enrolled, under the name of Peter Mitchell, at on the 22nd day of October, 1863

as a Sergeant in Co. H. 9th Regt. U.S. C. Inf. Here state rank, and company and regiment, in the Army, or vessels, if in the Navy.

and honorably discharged November 26, 1866, having served ninety days or more during the late civil war.

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services if any.)

That he was not in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above

That she was married under the name of Margaret Jenkins to said soldier at Baltimore Md on the 9th day of August, 1870 by Rev Wm S. Wilson; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage, that she had not been previously married; that the soldier had not been previously married.

(If there was a prior marriage of either, the date and place of death or divorce of former consort or consorts should be stated.)

and that neither she nor said soldier married otherwise than is stated above.

That the said soldier died November 2, 1911, at Baltimore Md that she was not divorced from him, and that she has not remarried since his death.
