Sirs:

In the above entitled claim for pension under the act of June 27, 1890, claimant's name was dropped from the rolls December 4, 1894, on the ground that he was not ratably disabled for the performance of manual labor as shown by the evidence on file.

His name was again placed on the roll from July 16, 1897 under said act. His claim under the act of March 6, 1896 filed June 9, 1900 was rejected May 9, 1901, on the ground that claimant was not disabled for the performance of manual labor in a pensionable degree prior to July 16, 1897 when the renewal of pension was made to commence and adhering to the rejection of claim for renewal based on declarations filed January 7, 1895 and April 6, 1896.
