Sir:

This soldier has received \$12 per month since February 11, 1907, under the Act of February 6, 1907. The attorney appeals from the medical action dated April 6, 1911, refusing to reopen the claims under the Acts of June 27, 1890, and March 6, 1896, contending that the applicant should be pensioned at \$12 per month from December 4, 1894, the date when his name was dropped from the rolls under the Act of June 27, 1890.

All the papers in this case have been carefully reconsidered and it appears that the medical actions under the Act in question were taken in accordance with the practice of the Bureau existing on their various dates and that no injustice has been done the claimant. Therefore the action in contention is adhered to.
