On this 24 day of February, 1922, at Baltimore county of Baltimore City, State of Maryland before me, W. H. Stovall, a Special Examiner of the Bureau of Pensions, personally appeared Nannie Grant, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to her during this special examination of aforesaid claim for pension, deposes and says:

1 I am 46 years old, am the wife of William E. Grant,
2 and my post office address is 2031 Division st, Baltimore
3 Md. I have lived in Baltimore my entire life and have
4 known Mrs Annie Heath for 28 or 30 years and she was liv-
5 ing in Dover street in Baltimore, she rented out rooms
6 and I went there as one of her lodgers, at the time our
7 acquaintance started and going by the name of Annie Dailey.
8 I knew her when I was a right young girl but dont feel
9 safe in saying I have known her longer than 28 years.
10 Annie Heath and I have been friends ever since our acquaint-
11 tance started, I was in her house for years and years, and
12 was married from her house and have lived in her neighbor-
13 hood ever since my marriage. Annie Dailey has contracted
14 but one marriage since I have known her and that was to
15 Jacob Heath with whom I was well acquainted and I know that
16 she lived with Heath as his wife until his death.
17 I do not know where Annie Dailey got the name of Dailey and
18 I have never known her parents or other members of her family.
19 I have never known one Charles R. Dailey in this connection.
20 I have no information concerning any marriage of this
21 woman to one Charles R. Dailey of Baltimore. Annie was liv-
22 ing alone in Dover street in Baltimore and renting out
23 rooms when I first knew her. No man was living with her
24 and Jacob Heath is the first consort she has had to my
25 knowledge. Annie Heath has always claimed that she was not
26 married prior to her marriage to Jacob Heath and I have be-
27 lieved what she said. I saw her married to Jacob Heath.
