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I certify that I searched the marriage records of Baltimore Md, filed with the clerk of common pleas court, for the name of Jacob A. Heath or Haith from 1860 to June 6, 1900 (date of marriage to claimant) and the name was found only in the following connection:

April 1, 1867 license issued to Jacob Haith to marry Frederica E. Brown, ceremony to be performed by Schuman, and no return was made on the license.

August 3, 1898 Jacob Heath, colored, age 50, residence Baltimore Md, divorced, and Sedonia Mason, colored, 30 years old, were married by Rev Mr Mason.

Search was made of the marriage records for the name of Charles Dailey or any similar name from 1870 to December 1 1886 when the following entry was found: December 1, 1886 Charles R. Dailey, age 34, colored, ^{single,} residence Baltimore City, married to Mary M. Dailey, colored, single, age 24 years. The records are complete for the period specified.

I certify that I searched the divorce records of Baltimore Md, filed with the clerks of circuit court No 1 and No 2, for a record of any proceedings between Jacob A. Heath or Haith and any wife of any name whatsoever - from 1860 to July 21, 1898 (date of divorce from the wife Harriet Heath) and the name was not found on the records in any connection. Only the circuit court possessed jurisdiction in divorce causes in Baltimore City Maryland during the period stated.
