Annie M., widow of Jacob Heath, Co. C., 19th U.S.C. Inf.

Act of May 1, 1920.

In cases submitted for special examination the papers should be indexed to show page numbers, names and addresses of claimants and witnesses, dates of filing, and subjects covered, a separate index being required for each brief. In indexing surgeons' certificates, dates of examination, not of filing, should be stated.

- 1 Claimant, Aug. 6, 1921, declaration.
- 2 Oct. 29, 1921, aff., lived with man named Charles Dailey who later married and remarried and is living with his wife, soldier was under the impression that claimant was Dailey's widow, claimant was not married to Charles Dailey.
- 3 Dept. of Public Safety, Baltimore, Md., Aug. 6, 1921, certified copy of public record of soldier's death.
- 4 Clk. of Ct. of Common Pleas, Baltimore, Md., Aug. 12, 1921, certified copy of public record of marriage between soldier and claimant.
- 5 W.H. Stovall, Sp. Ex., Sept. 9, 1921, letter to Commissioner dated at Baltimore, Sept. 7, 1921.
- 6 Soldier, June 3, 1898, marriage circular, married Harriet Jane Brown at Baltimore, Md. on Nov. 24, 1884 who has applied for divorce, was previously married to Elizabeth Heath on May 19, 1884 at Baltimore, Md.
- 7 Jan. 28, 1901, marriage circular, married to claimant on Jun. 6, 1901 at Baltimore, Md., previously married to Harriet Jane Heath from whom he was divorced Jul. 22, 1898 at Baltimore, Md.
- 8 Feb. 21, 1918, marriage circular, was previously married to Sidoni Heath who died on Feb. 16, 1900 at Baltimore, Maryland.
- 9 William E. Grant, 2031 Division St., Baltimore, Md., Aug. 6, 1921, aff soldier remained single between Feb. 14, 1900 and Jun. 6, 1900; soldier and claimant lived together as man and wife from until his death.
- 10 Mamie Grant, 2031 Division St., Baltimore, Md., Aug. 6, 1921, aff., same as above.
- 11 Dept. of Public Safety, Baltimore, Md., Aug. 6, 1921, certified copy of public record of death of former wife, Sedonia Hall.
- 12 Clk. of Circuit Ct., Baltimore, Md., Aug. 6, 1921, certified copy of decree of divorce between Harriet Heath and soldier.
- 13 Dept. of Public Safety, Baltimore, Md., Aug. 6, 1921, certified copy of public record of death of former wife Elizabeth Heath.
- 14 Perry W. Johnson, 912 Whatcoat St., Baltimore, Md., Nov. 1, 1921, aff., soldier was not married other than mentioned, soldier and claimant lived together as husband and wife from the date of their marriage to the date of the soldier's death.
- 15 Isaiah Brown, 1307 Division St., Baltimore, Md., Nov. 1, 1921, aff., same as above.
- 16 Charles R. Dailey, 916 Pierce St., Baltimore, Md., Oct. 29, 1921, aff., lived with claimant for about four years, claimant remained single from 1886, soldier was claimant's only legal husband, they lived together as husband and wife from marriage to his death.
- 17 St. Paul M.E. Church, Saratoga and Schroeder Sts., Baltimore, Md., Oct. 29, 1921, copy of church record of marriage between Charles R. Daily and Mary M. Daily.

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
