DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 25th day of March, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and seven, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Jacob Heath, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 65 years of age, and a resident of 1349 N. Calhoun St. City of Baltimore, State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Benedict Md. under the name of Jacob A. Heath, on the 25 day of December, 1863, as a private, in Co. B 19th Reg. W. V. C. Infantry (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Brownsville Texas, on the 15 day of January, 1867. That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 7 1/2 inches; complexion, ruff; color of eyes, black; color of hair, black; that his occupation was a farmer; that he was born January 1, 1842 at Queen Anne Co. Md.

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Baltimore City Md. (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he is a pensioner. That he has heretofore applied for pension certificate No. 116,726 at rate of two per month act June 27th 1890 (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is 1349 N. Calhoun St. City of Baltimore, State of Maryland.

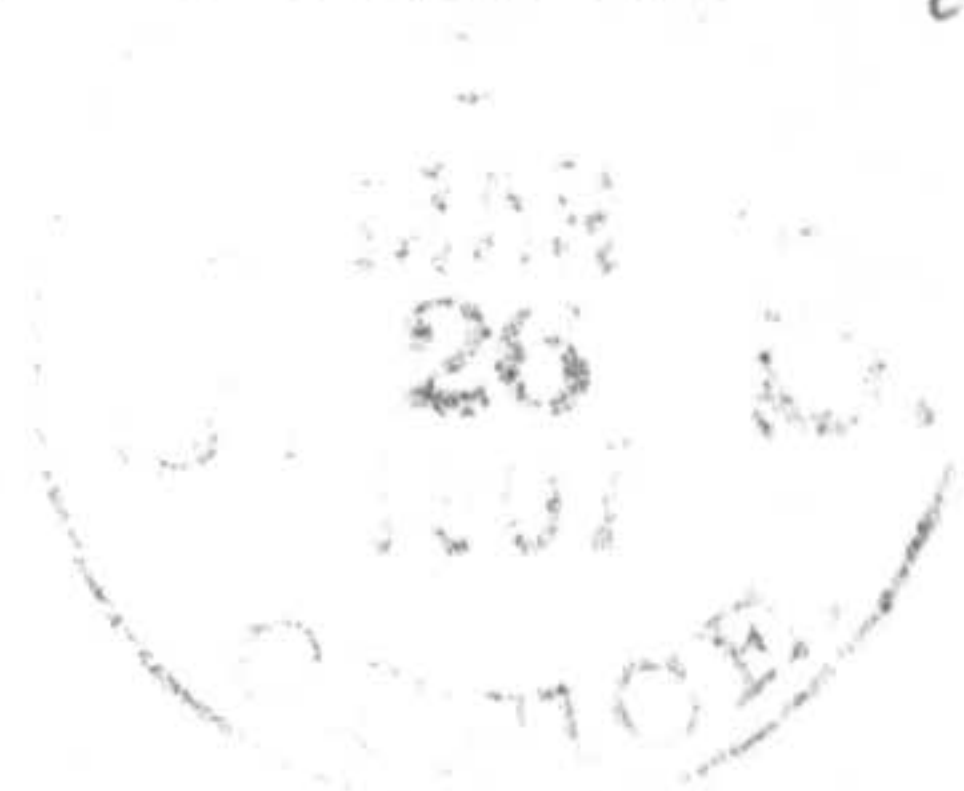
