Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.

Catarrh: Naso pharyngeal tract healthy. Eustachian tubes pervious. Hearing not impaired. He has no catarrh.

Eyes: External and internal structures each eye normal. Vision each eye 20/20.

Facts within the knowledge of the Board, or any member thereof, relative to the cause of any disability found should be stated.

Whenever a disability is shown or is believed to be due to or aggravated by vicious habits the opinion of the board must be stated. When not due to such habits this fact must be stated.

Kidneys: No local oedemas or dropsies. No degenerations. No anaemia or uraemia. Urine light amber. S. G. 1020. Acid. No albumen or sugar.

Rheumatism: He has crepitation in all his large joints with pain on motion. No deformity or limitation of motion of joints. He has no objective symptoms of rheumatism. He complains of muscular soreness extending over whole body. Heart--Apex impulse visible in fifth interspace, one inch to right of left nipple. Cardiac dullness extends from apex, to middle of sternum and to fourth left chondrocostal articulation. Action is regular and valves in good condition. No dyspnea, cyanosis or oedema. No hypertrophy or dilatation.

Except as above, all organs normal. Chest symmetrical; expiration 36, rest 37, inspiration 39.

No evidence of vicious habits. No disability found to exist
