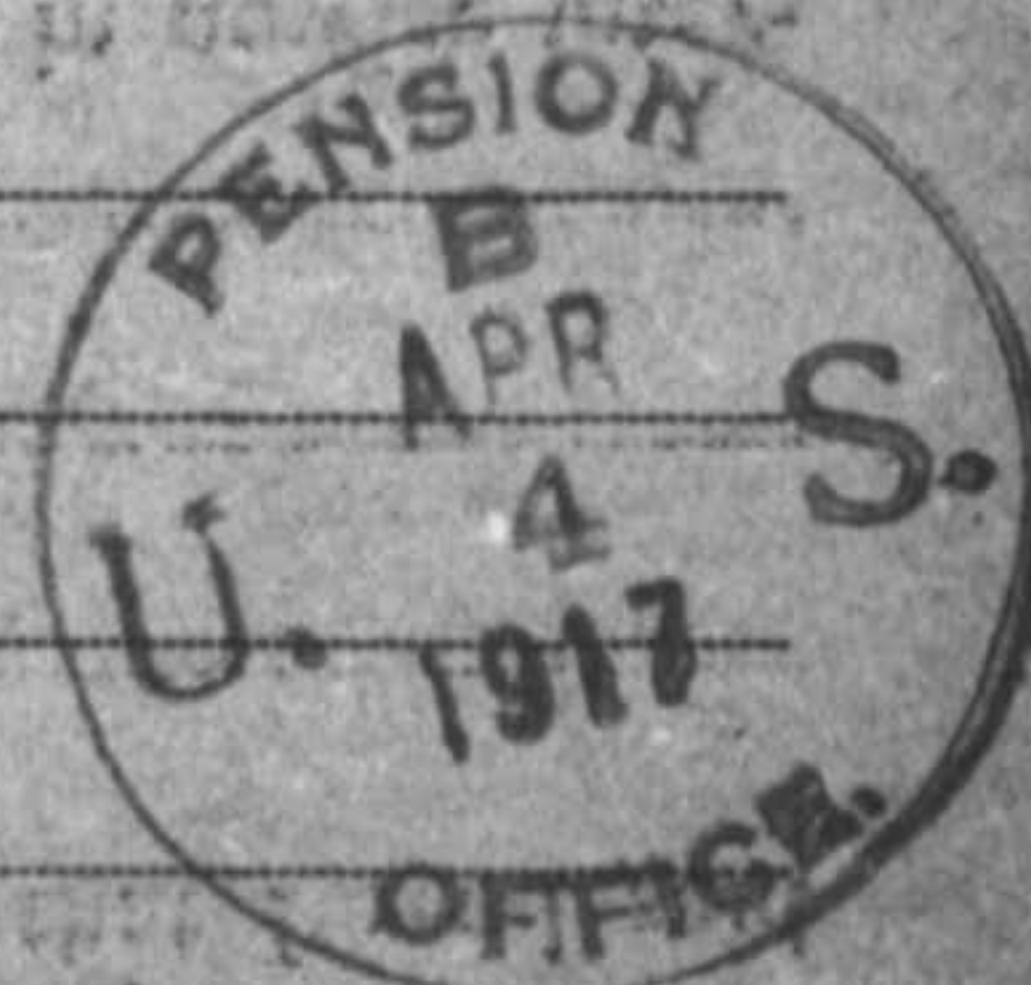
ON THIS 31st day of March, A. D. 1917, personally appeared before me
