 29 at Eight Mile Hill two miles from Ellieott City where she was
 30 in service with a good white family and just saw her and Hall as
 31 well as Mr Chase on sundays at church or passing on the road, my
 32 cousin always always coming alone on her visits to my premises.
 33 I have ^{not} known of Eliza Jackson living or cohabiting with any other
 34 men. If married before her marriage to Amos Jackson it would
 35 have been in Howard County or in Baltimore City Md for her home
 36 has been nowhere else since I can recollect her. She resided in
 37 Baltimore after her marriage to Jackson, and was not divorced from
 38 him to my knowledge, and has not remarried since his death. I do
 39 not know the cause of their separation except that both were high
 40 spirited and hasty. For years and years she had nothing to do
 41 with him. For ten or twelve years she never came near me. She
 42 is past living with men now because she is hopelessly crippled.
 43 I never knew Sarah or Sallie Weeks, or the wife Rebecca Jackson.
 44 I knew the late husband of this claimant only by the name of Amos
 45 Jackson. I have no preunary interest in the claim. Your ques-
 46 tions were understood and my answers are recorded correctly in
 47 this deposition which I have heard read. "Her" interlined in line
 48 25 before deposition was signed, and "not" in line 33.
