On January 15th, we wrote to you in regard to
Eliza or Elizabeth Jackson, 557 W. Biddle Street, whose
husband, James E. Jackson, Company H, 19 U.S.T. Inf.,

the pension can be renewed.

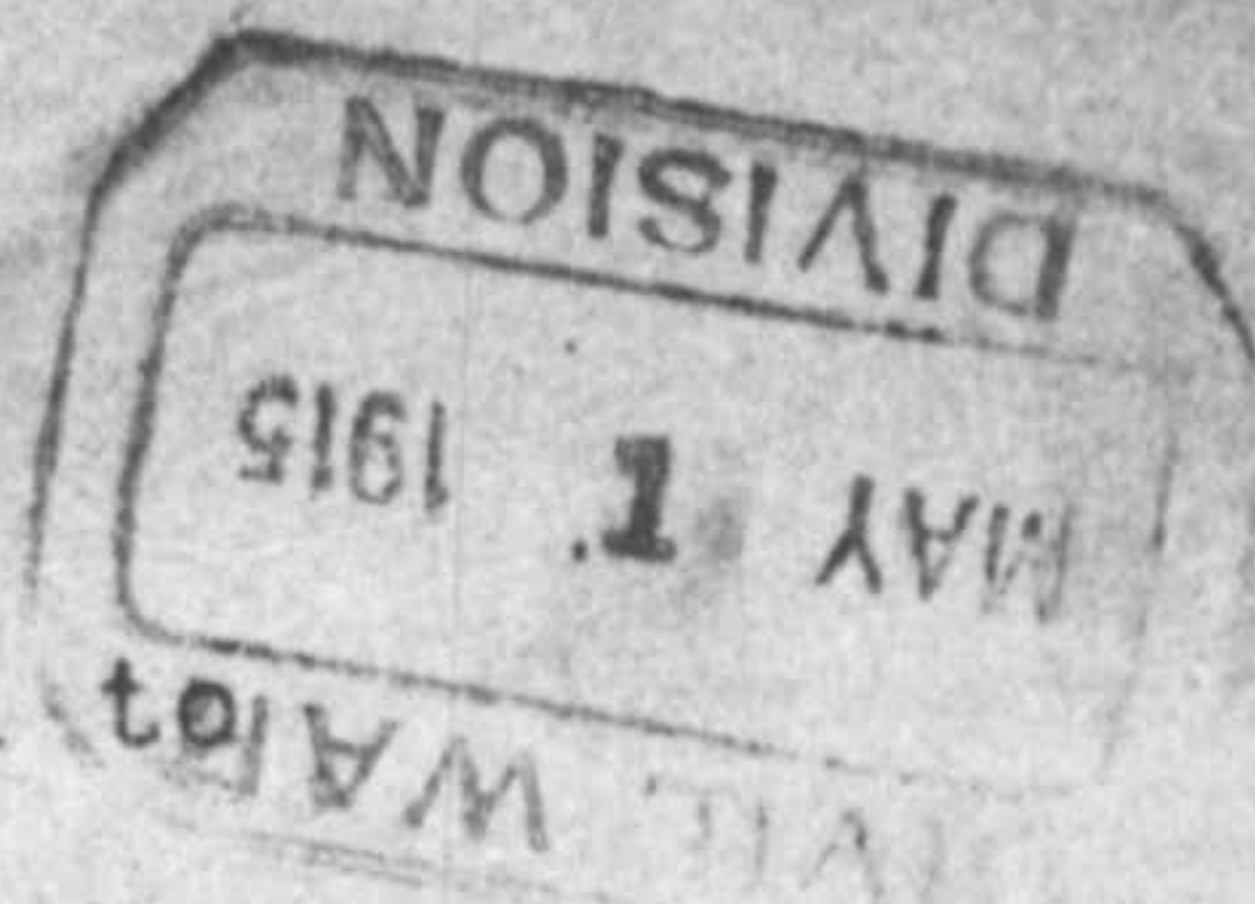
