In response to the letter of Lillian Hood, dated January 15, 1915, you are advised that your claim for pension requires, in addition to the evidence called for January 16, statements (under seal or oath) from the clerks of court of Baltimore, Maryland, and Hampton, Virginia--where the soldier lived--showing whether either you or he obtained or applied for divorce after his desertion of you; also the testimony of one witness who knew you from the time you became of marriageable age, showing whether you had been married prior to your marriage to the soldier,--to be considered with that of Martha Brown.
