Sir:

In the above-entitled claim for pension under the act of Apl. 19, 1908, as amended by the act of Sept. 8, 1916, there should be furnished a verified copy of the public or cemetery record of the sailor's death.

There is required a verified copy of the public or church record of the claimant's marriage to the sailor.

There should be furnished a verified copy of the public or cemetery record of the death of claimant's former husband, Francis Cooper, or, if no such records exist, the affidavit of the attending physician showing the date of death of said Cooper.

Claimant should furnish her own sworn statement setting forth whether her husband, Francis Cooper, ever served in the U. S. army or navy, and, if so, the letters of all companies and numbers of all regiments to which he belonged if in the army, or, if in the navy, the names of all the vessels on which he served, and the dates and places of enlistment and discharge in all cases.
