DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

On this 10th day of January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine
personally appeared before me, a COMMISSIONER OF DEEDS FOR DISTRICT OF
COLUMBIA, in and for the County and State aforesaid, James Jordan aged
43 years, a resident of the 1403 Parish Alley, City of Baltimore, State of Maryland,

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical James Jordan who was ENROLLED on the 29 day of February, 1864, in Company E of the 30th Regiment U.S. B. I. discharged April 15, 1864 transferred to the U.S. Navy U.S.S. New Hampshire commanded by [unclear] and was honorably DISCHARGED at the U.S. Navy yard from the U.S.S. Vermont on the 15 day of April, 1866; that his personal description is as follows: Age, years; height 5 feet 5 inches; complexion, dark; hair, Black; eyes, Brown

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Camp Belger, in the State of Maryland on or about the day of March, 1864, he from exposure contracted Rheumatism, Heart disease, Kidney trouble, & Vertigo in Head, from exposure and hardships.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: Camp Hospital Camp Belger Maryland

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the County of Howard in the State of Maryland + Balto City Md and his occupation has been that of a Farmer. That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a That he is now totally disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation Charles G. Yantze, 26 G. Fayette St. Baltimore Md his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim.
