June date disabling him fully 1/2
of his time... I joined George Golden from
him from January 1866 to the present 1890
and we met often and talked of the war he worked
in the 39th Regiment 39th Regiment George Harris

I saw the above named soldier soon after his discharge
he was then suffering from rheumatism ^{he looked} weak and
moved about in a slow and painful manner
complained of pains and stiffness in his limbs
and joints lameness and rheumatic pains in
his entire system all the symptoms of one suffering
from rheumatism the disease has existed each
and every year since the above date disabling him
fully half of his time

we were in the 39th Regiment
