

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 5 day of May, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
personally appeared before me, Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court, a court of
record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Valentine Jones, aged
60 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore County of

State of Md, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares
that he is the identical Valentine Jones who was Enrolled on
the 1 day of July, 1863 in Company F of the 39 Regiment
of Md. Cal. Vols. commanded by Capt. F. Dodge
and who was honorably Discharged at Wilmington N.C. on the 4 day
of Dec., 1865; that his personal description is as follows: Age 60 years; height
5 feet 6 inches; complexion, brown; hair, gray; eyes, brown

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at
Wilmington N.C., in the State of N.C.

on or about the 30 day of May, 1864 he Contracted
rheumatism through exposure, lying in
of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its causes; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.
damp wet ground, & from which I have
suffered since, being now unable to perform
manual labor 2/3 the time.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows:
Here state the names or numbers and the localities of all hospitals in which treated,
and as near as possible, the dates of arrival and departure from each.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above
Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 4 day of
Dec., 1865. That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the
City of Baltimore in the State of Md., and
that his occupation has been that of a Laborer

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health,
being when enrolled a Farmer. That he is now Greatly
disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described,
received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of
being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints, with full power of
substitution and revocation,

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim That he has never received any applied for
