Madam:

In your claim for reimbursement in the above cited case, you are advised that a statement is required showing whether the pensioner left any money, real estate, or personal property, and if so, the character and value of all such property and whether there were any sick or death benefits paid on the pensioner's account and if so, the name of the company and the amount paid, and whether there was any insurance - life, accident, or health - in force on the life of the pensioner, and if so, the name of the company in which the policy was carried, the amount in which written, the beneficiary named, and by whom the premiums were paid.

This evidence is required for the reason that you failed to answer the questions relative to same on the application blank.
