DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 17 day of June, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and fourteen personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and state aforesaid, Benjamin Welch, who, being duly sworn according to law declares that he is 70 1/2 years of age, and a resident of Baltimore City

County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore Md under the name of

Benjamin Welch, on the 15 day of May, 1864, as a private, in Co D 19th Regt U.S.C. Inf

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore Md, on the 15 day of May, 1864
(State name of war, Civil or Mexican.)

That he also served in the service of the United States

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Baltimore Maryland

That he is a pensioner under certificate No 248,261

That he has not applied for pension under original No.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of May 11, 1912.
