Your inquiry of *Sept. 16th*, 1882, in Pension Claim No. *336.801*, is herewith returned, with the following information:

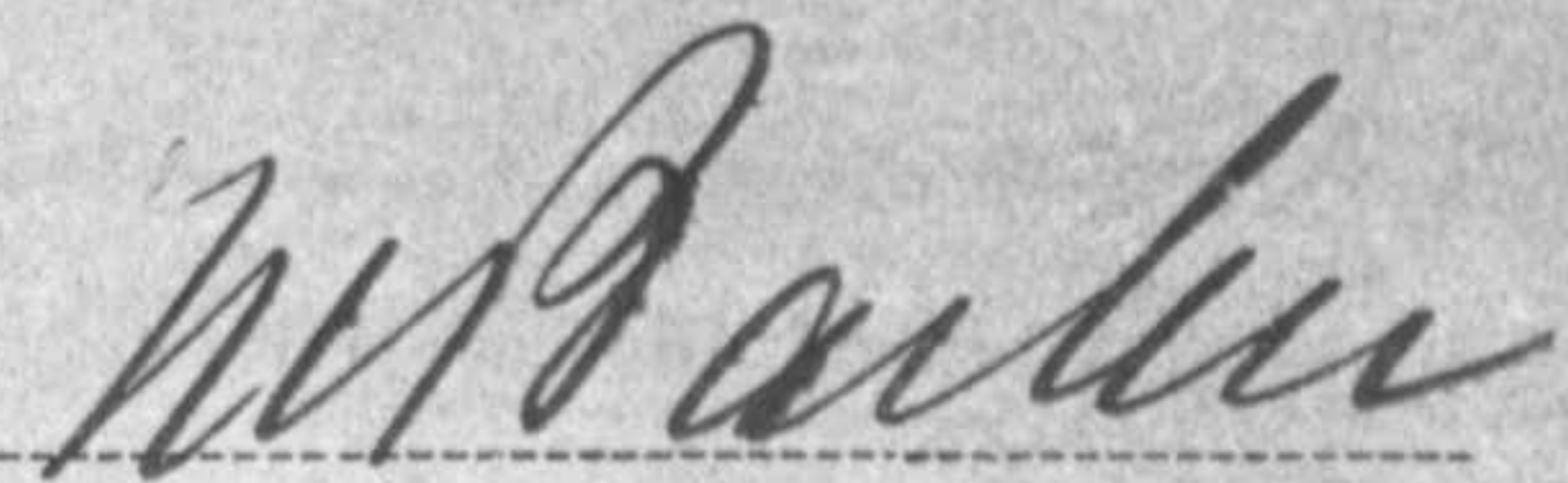
