Personally came before me, a Justice of the peace in and for aforesaid County
and State, Edward Parker, aged 49 years
and 110 Fried Hill Ave, aged years
citizen of the Town of Baltimore County of Baltimore, State of
Maryland
Post Office Address, , well known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and who,

being duly sworn, declare in relation to aforesaid case, as follows:

The Circumstances
under which my wounds were incurred have
already been set forth in a previous Affidavit
filed by me in this case. I can only add
that I was passing through a shower of
bullets fired by Infantry behind earthworks
at the Sugar Loaf Battery North Carolina on
the 11th day of February 1865. Whilst engaged
with my Regiment charging the enemy all the
injuries heretofore specified namely wound
in neck left eye and ear right arm. were received
at this time Evidently the Result of more
than one gun shot

I further declare that I have an interest in said case, and am concerned in
its prosecution.
