BASIS OF CLAIM.

Alleges in declaration filed July 12, 1880 at Annapolis Battery, D.C., July 11, 1865? while storming the Battery he was struck by a Minnie ball on right side of his neck. Near jugular vein, breaking off a piece of the lower jaw and knocking out several teeth, causing a permanent impediment in his speech. Also wound of right arm & near elbow, and left eye, losing a portion of left ear.
