widow of Perry Robinson who was a Private in Co. 19
of the 30 Regiment of 16th Regt Vols., in the war of 1861;
that her claim for a pension, on account of his death resulting from the service aforesaid, is on
file and now pending in the Office of the Commissioner of Pensions. And she makes this supple-
mentary affidavit in order to secure an increase of pension in accordance with the Act of Congress,
increasing pensions of widows and orphans, approved July 25, 1866.

And she further swears that she has 4 and only 4 child ren
of her said deceased husband and herself, under sixteen years of age, who are now living;
that the following are the names, date of birth, and present place of residence of said
child, to wit:

Thomas, born August 8 1853,
James born November 17 1854, Emma
born October 25 1856, and Perry
born May 22 1859.

And she further declares that no record
of names or birth is in existence,
none having been made &c
best of her knowledge & belief.

And she further swears that her said deceased husband left no minor child by a
former marriage.

nor."

and she hereby appoints Wm P. Drew
Agent for her and as her attorney to prosecute her
Pension claim against the United States
and to receive receipts for Cert. issued thereon.

She also declares that she has not remarried since the death of her said husband, nor has she
abandoned the support of any one of the above-named children, nor permitted any one of the same,
for whom she claims increase of pension, to be adopted by any other person or persons, as his, her,
or their child.

represents herself to be, and that they have no interest in the prosecution of this claim.

They further say that she still remains the widow of the said Perry Robinson
and continues to support all her children named in her foregoing affidavit
on account of whom she claims an increase of pension.
