I recommend that the records at Baltimore City Md be searched for, a record of George W Harris marriage to Olivia Hawkins in 1869 (or 1870), of her death about eight to ten years after (perhaps longer?) as to any subsequent marriage by soldier, and that the following named persons be seen as to soldier's physical condition from discharge to death in 1885, and dependence, and sub marriage.
