A Yes, He married a girl named  
Chivva Neaulkin in Baltimore  
Md, after I left the city, I left  
Baltimore in 1866, and I was  
away from there three or four  
years before his marriage. He  
came to see me while I was  
living in the Shenandoah Valley, and  
he was not married then.

Q What became of George's wife?

A She died in Baltimore Md, about  
nine or ten years after their marriage,  
I cannot give the date of her  
death. They were married in  
what was then called the Orchard  
St Church, now called the Metropolitan  
Law Church. They lived while  
they were married, at 62 Biddle  
Alley Baltimore Md. I went  
there to see them once. I never  
expected to be called upon for  
such information so I never  
kept any memoranda showing  
dates.

Q Did your son have any children  
by his wife?

A They had four or five children but  
they were all, either born dead  
or else lived only an hour or
