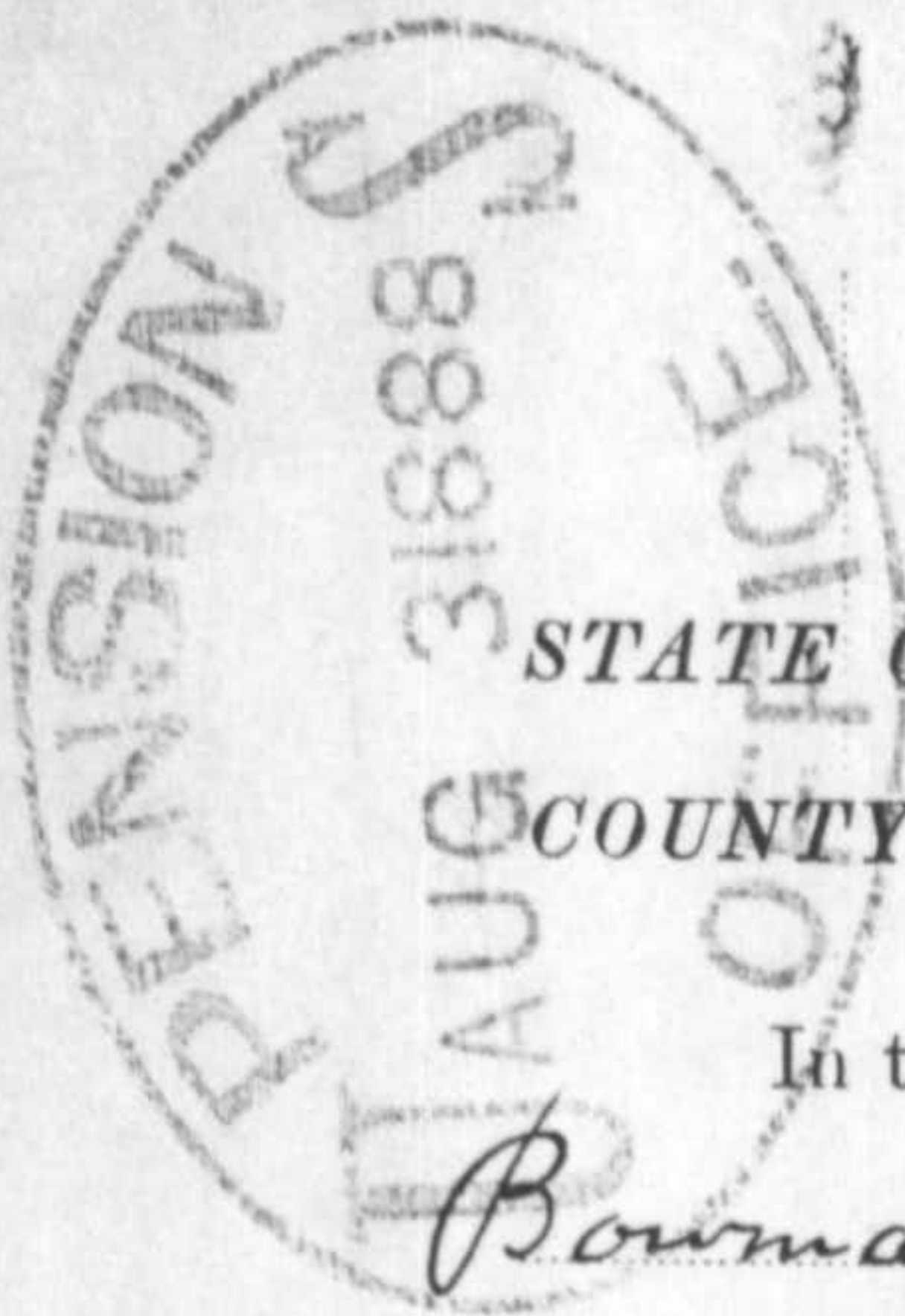


GENERAL AFFIDAVIT.
