applicant in the year of 1872 also declares that the Wife of Geo. W.
Harris died March 15th 1877. they were
then living in Baltimore Md.

Geo. W. Harris aided his mother during
the three years previous to his death
he sent her at one time ten dollars, at
an other \$25.⁰⁰ he ^{sent} her money at an
other time I do not know the amount
he wrote her a letter shortly before his
death. Stating that after his death
he wanted her (Hester A Bowman)
to have all that was coming to him.

Property of Hester A Bowman, I suppose
was worth about, Two hundred dollars.
I am a nephew of Geo. W. Harris
