The Adj. General reports that Charles E. Smith was mustered as Private 22 March 1864, and

Death.

Died at U.S. Gen. Hospital Ft Monroe 9 March 1865. Surgeon Gen reports admitted to Hospital 28 December 1864 from Field with Hemorrhage from lungs and died 9 March 1865 of Valvular Disease of Heart. It is shown by testimony of Privates that Smith was healthy until he took cold from exposure being compelled to lay out in a snow storm, &c.

Charles E. Smith and Hester Waters were married 16 March 1869 as shown by witnesses who were present, Clergyman shown to be dead, &c.
