We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Rheumatism; Weak Back; Diarrhoea; Piles, Throat trouble.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for Original [Original, increase, restoration, &c.]
Rheumatism in both shoulders, neck and back.
Has attacks of diarrhoea, occurring about every two months.
Suffers with internal piles, which protrude when he has diarrhoea.
Constant dryness in the throat.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 76; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 2 inches; weight, 115 pounds; age, 54 years. General physical condition fair.

Rheumatism: Crepitation in both shoulders, with marked pain on motion, extending through the muscles of the back. No deformity of the joints. Has sensitiveness to pressure across the lumbar regions, with pain when stooping, and on motions of the body.

Heart and Lungs are normal.

Area of hepatic dulness somewhat increased, with sensitiveness in the hepatic region and in the epigastrium. Spleen is normal.

Rectum: Speculum shows one large internal hemorrhoid, one-half inch in diameter; rectum is congested; hemorrhoidal veins enlarged. Probably suffers with attacks of Diarrhoea at times, as claimed.

No other disability exists.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 6/18 rating for the disability caused by Rheumatism for that caused by Diarrhoea + Piles, and 6/18 for that caused by _____
