

appeared William H. Sheppard, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him, deposes and says

I am 54 years of age, I have no occupation, reside and my city address is 1112 Ething sh. Baltimore. I was sgt Co. D. 30th Reg. P.C.T. from March 1864 till June 1865. This clmk was a member of my regt but I cant say as to his Co. he was not of my Co. He enlisted with me ~~and~~ but I cant say when he was discharged. I first met him at enlistment, I think it was about one year after the war when I first seen him out of service, I cant say positively when I saw him last in service, Yes Sir, he was sick while in service he complained of rheumatism & I think diarrhoea, but not sure as to the last named. It was about Aug, 1864 while in Va near Bermuda Hundred. That he first complained to me of his rheumatism, said his shoulders & knee joints pained him, I think he went to some hospital, but cant say where. I think we came in N.C. when he went to hospital and I understood he had rheumatism when he went to hospital, No, I cant say when that was, Yes, it was after the summer of 1864 but I cant give time. I did not see him again in service after he went to hospital. No, I cant remember of him complaining of any ailment other than rheumatism & probably diarrhoea. No Sir. I know nothing of any lung trouble or bronchitis of his but since you mention it I remember that he complained to me of sore throat, I think that was in the winter of 1864. I cant say as to nature of same other than some 3 or 4 times he complained to me of sore throat. No I dont know what caused his ailments. I have heard you read from my affidavit. I have no recollection of his lung trouble & I dont think I said he had rheumatism & sore throat at Petersburg Va. & I know he did not have these ailments at the same time. I have understood your questions & my answers have been properly recorded.
