DEPOSITION

On this 15th day of June, 1894, at
 Balto. City, County of _____
 State of Md., before me, Gen. Cunnolly, a
 Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared John H.
 Murphy, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer
 truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of aforesaid
 pension claim, deposes and says: My age is 53; occupation
 printer; P.O. address, No. 1336 St. Carey
 St., Balto. City, Md.

I enlisted as a sergt in Co.
 B. 30th U.S.C.T. March 18, 1864,
 and was discharged in Dec., 1865.
 I was never in any other service.

I claim pension for rheumatism,
 disease of throat and lungs,
 and impaired hearing; the rheumatism
 I contracted in June or July, 1864,
 near Fish Pond, Va., by exposure; I
 was sent to field hospital, where I
 remained for a time; as I was out of
 my head, I can't give you any
 idea of how long I was in field
 hospital; I was sent from there
 to ~~the~~ general hospital at
 City Point, Va., where I remained
 until about Oct., 1864, and was
 then sent to ~~the~~ Hospital
 Alexandria, Va., where I remained
 until about Jan., 1865; the throat
 trouble was contracted at some
 time and place; the other dis-
 abilities have made their ap-
 pearance since service.
