

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

To be executed before some officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. The official character and signature of any such officer not required by law to use a seal must be certified by the clerk of the proper court, giving dates of beginning and close of official term.

John H. Murphy who was ENROLLED as a Sergeant on the 30 day of June, 1864, in Company G of the 30 Regiment of N. S. C.

commanded by Capt. S. J. and was honorably DISCHARGED at

Baltimore, on the 23 day of June, 1865; that his

personal description is as follows: Age 24 years; height 5 feet 6 inches; complexion yellow

hair black; eyes brown. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the

service and in the line of duty at near Fish Camp in the State of Virginia

on or about the 1st day of Summer, 1864, he contracted

bronchitis, or disease of throat, lungs, impaired hearing of left ear, rheumatism

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: Field Hospital at Alexandria

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore

in the State of Md., and that his occupation has been that of a printer

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a

free man That he is now partly disabled

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of

the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid

pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,
