I worked on Fort Magruder, sodding in front of the fort. I don't remember Jess Fry being there with Company, and of course do not remember him wearing any injury there.

I do now remember that he had spasms of falling spells and I have helped hold him down. Don't remember the names of the others who helped hold him down. It was while he carried his arm in the sling that he had the spasms. - Sometimes some times fifteen or twenty minutes, sometimes he would be senseless an hour. Frothed and frothed his teeth, clenched his fists and we would have to open his hands and beat the palms. - I saw him have more than three or four of those fits. They would come on him whenever he exerted himself the least. He never did much duty after he began carrying his arm in a sling, although he did before. I don't remember seeing any of our company digging the trench in front of Fort Magruder, although
