 and do not remember the
 nature of the injury - I think
 I saw him afterwards but do not
 remember anything except that
 he was camped all the time
 after working at Fort Mays
 where I think it was that he
 got hurt

I did not tent with him at
 all in service.

I remember now how he got hurt,
 he was on a scaffold in the trench
 and in dumping a tub of dirt
 he fell off the scaffold and hurt
 himself, but can't say positively
 where he got injured. I did
 not do much duty afterwards

The fall did not knock him
 senseless

I can't remember whether he
 or not fits in service, he may
 have had them.

I have seen him two or three
 times each year since discharge
 never worked with him since
 and never know of him having
 fits since discharge.
