I am not related to claimant
 and never knew him prior
 to my enlistment in company
 I-4th U.S. in the summer
 of 1863, at Camp Belgian, Md
 with the company all the time
 until wounded at Duleep Gapp
 Va. in 1864. After the Petersburg
 fight, was away from the com-
 pany nearly four months, and
 rejoined them at the same place
 and was discharged May
 5th 1866.

I know *Jesse Fry* was sick and
 complaining before I was wounded
 and that he was in the regt hospi-
 tal after, but when and where
 he was first taken sick I don't
 remember, I don't know the
 nature of his sickness.
 I know that he and *Stoth* worked
 on fortifications, on the Appomattox
 River near Petersburg.
