send me the statement of your treatment to me while in the Government Service. For Epilepsy and injury of my wrist which occurred at Williamsburg. Pa. while digging the interlockment around Fort Mifflin. I got through from the scaffold about six feet high down with the bit and fell on my wrist which disabled me. I got crippled in 1864. and in '64 in March the two companies returned to Yorktown Pa. the Regiment and when they started on
