And I have no interest in the claim of William Wells for Pension

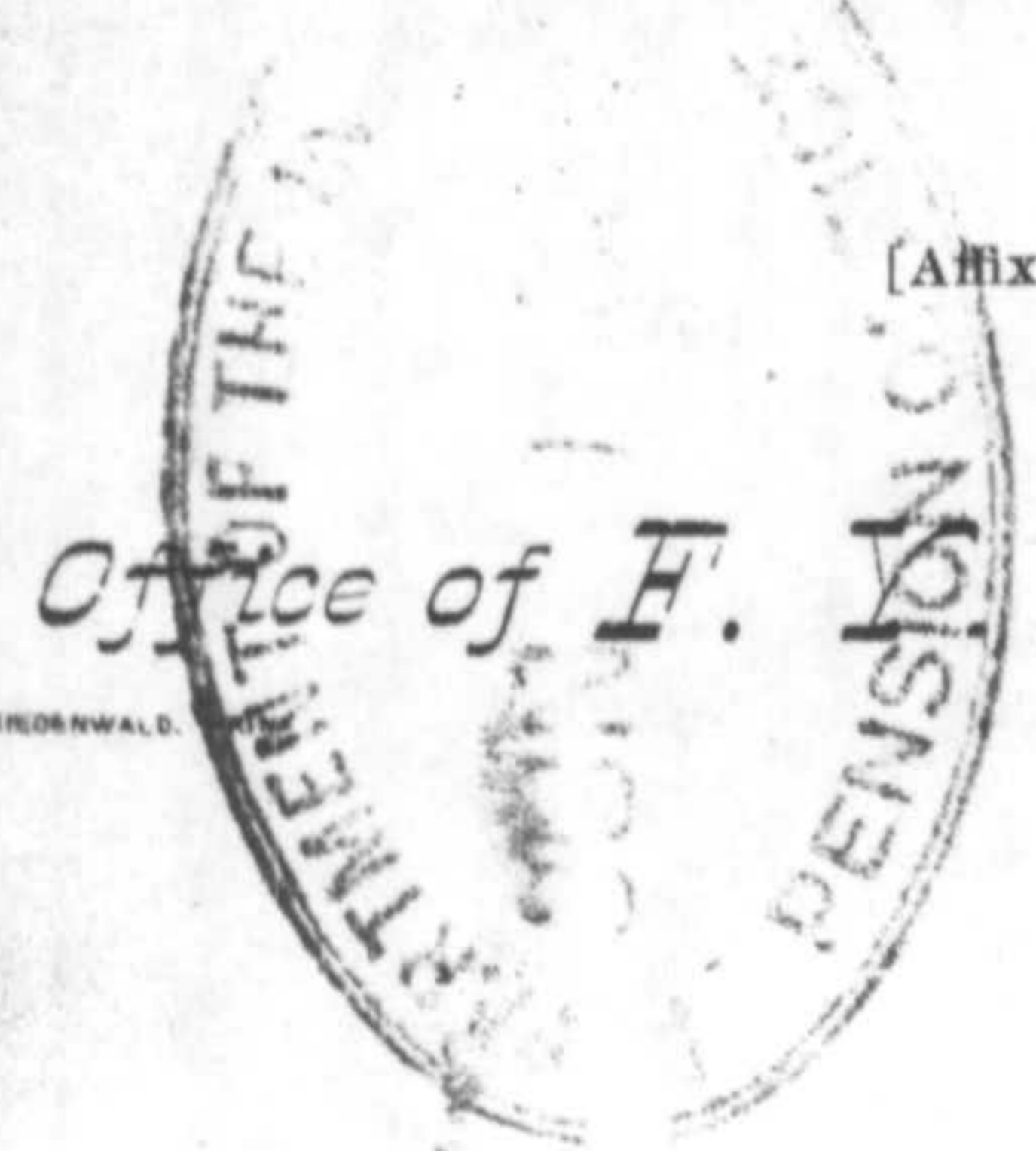
