day of July 1864 - we were present

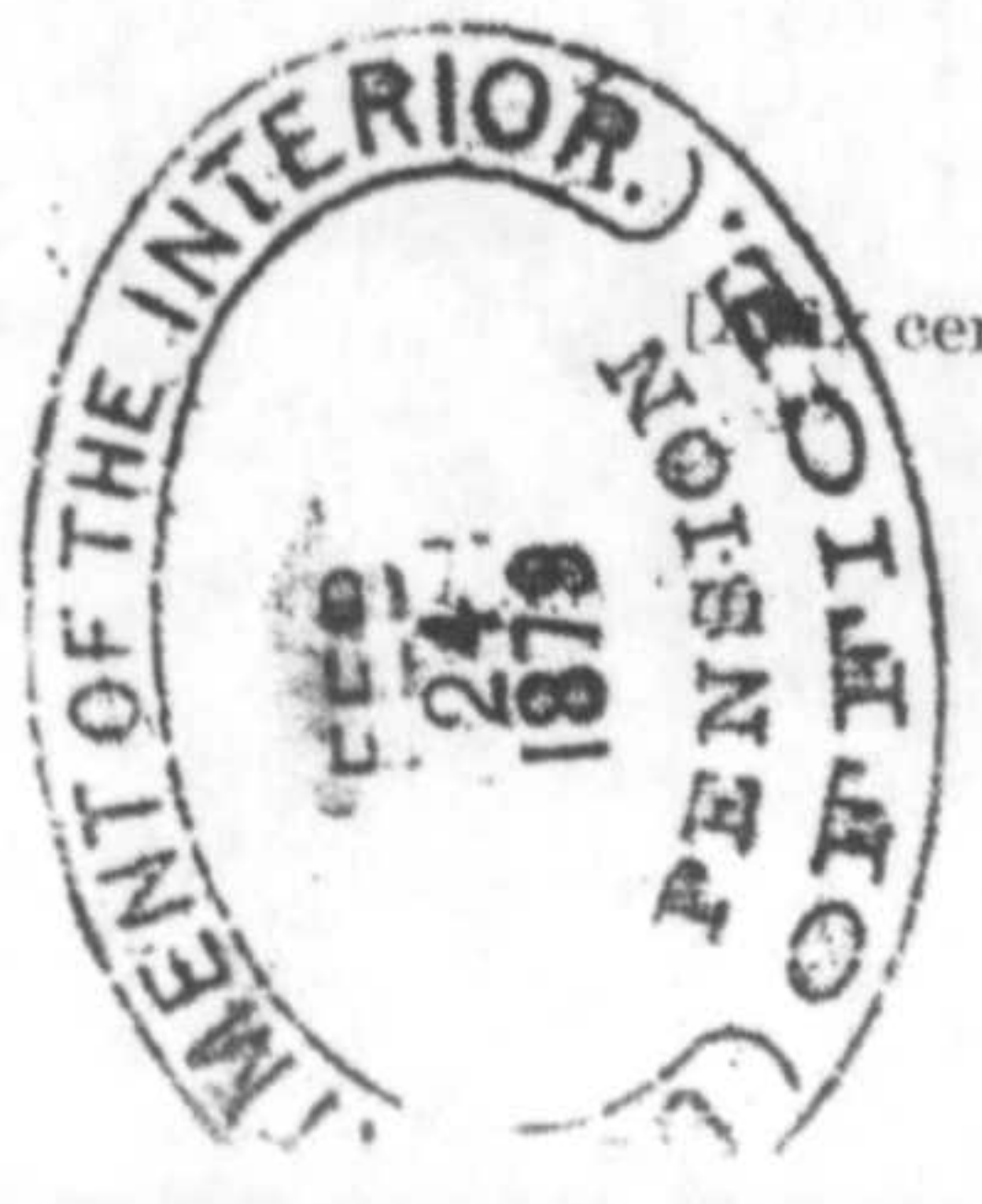
and we have no interest in the claim of William Wells for Pension
