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# EXAMINING SURGEON'S CERTIFICATE

It is hereby certified That William Wells Company,

in the 19 Regiment of U S C T, in the war of 1865-  
who is now paid at Washington Agency at the rate  
of 4 dollars per month, on account, as he states, of G. S. U. Right  
Wrist

while in the line of duty in the military service of the United States, on or about the  
3 day of July, 1864, at a place called Petersburg  
in the State or Territory of Va  
is still suffering in consequence of said G. S. U. Right Wrist

Here specify the particular disease or injury.

The disability originates entirely from the injury or disease on account of which he was originally pensioned, as follows:

Height, 5, 7 1/2; weight, 160; complexion, Rk  
age, 48; respiration, 17; pulse, 80

Here state fully and accurately the character of the pensioner's disability, and how he is at present affected thereby; also, state whether the disability is permanent in its present degree, and whether it has been in any degree caused or protracted by vicious habits.

G. S. U. Right Wrist: Ball entered upper aspect of right wrist upper part, passed down and out at lower part of same: the hand is now atrophied 2 inches in circumference: prehensile power unimpaired: the ring and little fingers are permanently contracted: the small finger is partly paralyzed, the ring finger is numb: the wound had sloughed leaving a prominent elevated cicatrix on outer side of wrist: the use of the hand is less than it was a year ago

We find his disability, as described above, to be equal to, and entitling him to 3/4 \$ 6,00

Examining Surgeon:

The Surgeon will forward his report of examination direct to the Pension Office whether the pensioner is thought to be entitled to increase or not.
