

Declaration for

Pension.

TAKE NOTICE.—If this declaration is executed before a Justice of the Peace or a Notary Public, the certificate of the CLERK OF THE COURT, as to the official character and genuineness of the signature of such officer must be attached. Neglect to comply with this requirement will cause trouble and DELAY.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 31st day of January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, William Wells aged 49 years, a resident of Baltimore County of Baltimore State of Maryland

, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of \$12

dollars per month, Certificate No. 186,109; by reason of disability from gunshot wounds (Here name the disability for which pension was granted.) of right wrist and resulting partial paralysis

incurred in the military service of the United States, while serving as a Private (Here state rank, company, and regiment, if in the army; vessel if in the Navy.) C. C. 19 U. S. I.

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of increased disability and injury to back incurred from carrying logs at Benedict (Here state reasons for applying for increase. If on account of increase in the disability for which already pensioned, that should be described. If

MS in Dec 1863 building quarters affecting limbs on account of disability for which not pensioned, the location of the wound or injury, the name of the disease, and the time, place and circumstances as bone fever or rheumatism as set forth in a former declaration of its origin, and the names of hospitals, where treated in the service, should be fully stated. The dates of treatment should be given as nearly as possible.)

And for re-rating upon the ground that the rating of his original pension was too low and erroneous having only been paid at \$4 per month from his discharge up to 9 September 1881 when his rating was changed to \$12

That he asks that he be ordered for examination before the Pension Office or Washington Board of Surgeons

that he hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, A. Parlett Lloyd of 9 East Lexington St. his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim. His Post Office address is 514 St Mary St. Baltimore Md
