October 13, 1866, at Indianola, Texas, a Corporal, appointed
October 31, 1864.

Records on file do not show injury alleged nor
any other injury or disability at any time
during service.

Name not borne on Regt Hospital Register covering
May 64, to Sept, 65, nor on Regt Recd. Books
covering June, to Oct, 1866,
Co. Morning Reports cover Dec 65, to July 66,
and Returns cover Nov, 65, to Aug 66, sub
June 64, April and Oct, 1865.
