DEPOSITION *C*Case of *Horace Gibson*, No. *536135*

On this *9th* day of *May*, 188*8*, at
Easton, County of *Falbot*
 State of *Wd*, before me, *Marion Smith*, a
 Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared
Thomas Sampson, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer
 truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of afore-
 said pension claim, deposes and says: *I am now fifty*
years of age - P. O. is Easton, Falbot
Co. Wd. - I am a mail rider.
I was a private in Co. B. 4th Regt.
U. S. C. T. during the late war of
the rebellion. I was mustered into
the army in Sept 1863 and was
discharged in November 1866.
The claimant in this case, Horace
Gibson was a member of my
company. We were mustered into
the service at the same time. - I re-
member that while we were near
Dutch Gap, Va, he said to me that
he was swollen in his private, but
did not say what was the cause of
it. He showed me the swollen
or injured parts. As near as I can
come at it his right groin was the
part most affected. I cant say
when he was injured as he did
not tell me. To the best of my
remembrance he was not treated
during his term of service in the
army. Since the war closed I
have seen him every month or
two and he has always complained
of suffering with the injury

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
