 this Twentieth day of April, 1866, at Crownsville
Texas by reason of letter from War Dept dated War Dept Washington
March 27th 1866
 (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)*

Said Aelson Lorn was born in Hagerstown Washington
 in the State of Maryland, is 18 years of age,
five feet five inches high, Black complexion, Black eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer
 Given at Crownsville Tex this Twentieth day of
April 1866.

*This sentence will be erased should there be anything
 in the conduct or physical condition of the soldier
 rendering him unfit for the Army.
