 the time as I remember I don't re-
 collect that he went to any hos-
 pital, he might have gone to
 the doctor but I don't remember
 he did.

I can't tell you in what month
 I first noticed that Nelson was
 sick I can't describe his sickness
 any better than I have he was in
 a bad way I know and spit up
 blood the last of it.

Nelson died of consumption so
 they tell me he went to Washington
 soon after the war and there is
 where he died he was never well
 after he was sick at Bermuda
 Hundred, Va.
