I haven't any property of any kind
except a bed bureau and two chairs
which my daughter is keeping for
me. My son got a disease in the army
a bad cold which run into consumption.

I never heard my son say where he
got his cold but the first night after
he got home he coughed all night
long. He was nothing but a boy and not married.

Nelson staid here about a year and
then went to Washington because he
could get light work there.

When he was here in Hagerstown,
Md., after the war Nelson worked for
Dr. Norman B. Scott. He went to Wash-
ington he went with Alfred Applman
a steel contractor, who now lives in
Newark Ohio.

Jane Meyer, was present when my
husband died. Dr. George Fechtig was
present when my husband died. Jane
Meyer lives in Pittsburg Pa.

None of my children ever contributed
anything to my support except
Nelson, Mary and Henrietta, Nelson
I have lived with Mary and Hen-
rietta, some, Nelson, couldn't earn
much of anything after the war.

When my son went into the army
he worked for the Bumbachs
but they are dead, he boarded at home.

I can't give you the names of any
more witnesses that knew Nelson before
he went into the army.

When my son came home from
the army he was treated by Dr. Frederick
Downey, near of Los Angeles, Cal. and he
went to see Dr. Lee, of Hagerstown
but he is dead now.
