"The records do not report the circumstances under which clerk, was wounded Sept. 29 1864 but do show that his Co. was in action on that date near New Market Road, "losing heavily in killed wounded & missing." —

PAROL EVIDENCE AS TO ORIGIN OF DISABILITY.

Testimony of ~~commissioned officer~~ J. H. Jenkins (Serg. Co. C, 7th U. S. C. T. (Service verified by A. G.))(filed, May 23, 1872), that affiant was with his Co. at the battle of Fort GilmanVa. Sept. 29, 1864. & that clerk was wounded in the right hand & right arm by a minié
ball, further that he has known clerk, ever since & that the wound there receivedhas greatly disabled him.
