

Testimony of Comrades Alexander Brown & Nehemiah Dewley, (Co. C. 7th U.S.C.T. & Co. K. 39, U.S.

(filed, July 10th, 1872), that they knew Clint, & were both in the service as above

& distinctly remember that Sept. 29, 1864, at the battle of Fort Gilmer, Clint, was wounded

in the right arm by a Minnie ball & also lost part of the thumb of the right hand, that

A. Brown, was present when the wound was received, & when Clint, was taken to Hosp., & that

the other affiant (N. Dewley) saw him shortly after. — (Since verified by A.G.)
