We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred

Cause of disability.

in the service, viz: Wound of right arm and thumb; amputation of right thumb; Impaired Vision both Eyes: Rheumatism in the arms and shoulders.

and that he receives a pension of \$4.00 dollars per month.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for Increase.

[Original, increase, restoration, &c.]

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Claims to have received a G.S.W. of the right arm. When lifting any weight the arms becomes cramped, and as consequence cannot perform manual labor. Also a portion of the right thumb was injured.

Impaired vision, both eyes.

Makes no claim for rheumatism.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 80; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 5 inches; weight, 146 pounds; age, 49 years. General physical condition fair.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Scar of entrance of G.S.W. on the anterior and outer aspect of the right arm, at the outer border of the biceps, about the middle, 3/4 inch in diameter; depressed; adherent; dragging and sensitive. Ball passed directly backwards, emerging on the posterior aspect of the arm, about the same level, and two inches from point of entrance. The scar of exit is of the same size and general description as that of entrance. Ball passed through the outer aspect of the biceps and Triceps. Claims to have pain when using the arm.

The right thumb has been amputated about the middle of the proximal phalanx; stump is rounded and good. Scar is non-sensitive.

No evidence whatever of rheumatism.

Heart, Lungs and Abdominal Organs normal.

No other disability exists.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 4/18 rating for the disability caused by G.S.W. of Rt. Arm. for that caused by Specific and Loss, Right Thumb. for that caused by
