Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared Louisa A.Henry, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to her during this Special Examination of aforesaid pension claim, deposes and says: he was excused from duty.I know of no one by whom I can show that soldier incurred capture in the service except Perry and Robert-Muxley. Perry Muxley lives in Hagerstown Md. Robert-Muxley does not now live at Hagerstown Md. I think Perry Muxley can tell ^{where} Robert-lives. James Hilllate of Hagerstown Md is dead. I recollect of attending his funeral. I know of no doctor by whom soldier was treated after his discharge except Dr. N. B. Scott. ~~Dr.~~ Dr. Warham and Dr. Ragan. Dr.Warham attended soldier for grippe during the winter of 1894. I do not know any one except the Muxleys who would know of soldier's condition at discharge. I was not acquainted at Hagerstown Md. prior to my marriage. I do not know Geo. W. Elliot. I have heard him read the list of comrades. I have heard soldier speak of all of them. He often speaks of Solomon Sims. I can give no further information relative to the origin of soldier's hernia ~~or~~ as to his condition prior to my marriage to him in 1891.
